## CLASS STYLES

#### **JAZZ**

Jazz is a fun, energetic and dynamic style of dance that is great for all ages. Each Jazz class is highly engaging, having a strong emphasis on musicality, technique and coordination. Appropriate Jazz foundations and skills are taught to each age group where we focus on building confident dancers in an inclusive environment.

#### **CLASSICAL BALLET**

Ballet is an inspiring style of dance known for its elegance, precision and strength. The art of ballet is continually evolving and provides an excellent grounding that translates across all styles of dance. We have 2 RAD RTS Qualified Teachers and offer the Royal Academy of Dance Classical Ballet Syllabus, which is recognised worldwide as the leading organisation for classical ballet education. We also offer RAD Examinations.

#### **LYRICAL**

Lyrical and Modern Expressive is an extension of Classical Ballet that is comprised of fluid movements. Lyrical combines many of the technical elements of ballet, with the freedom and expressiveness of modern dance. This style primarily focuses on demonstrating emotion through the interpretation of music.

#### **CONTEMPORARY**

Contemporary dance is based around classical techniques and the discipline of distinct, unique and versatile movements. Contemporary dance explores creative choreography with the aid of music to build dynamics and strengthen story telling and self expression.

#### **HIP HOP**

Hip Hop refers to choreographed movements that have evolved from hip hop culture, encompassing a wide range of dance styles and music. These primarily include popping, locking, breaking, funk styles and lyrical hip hop. Hip Hop allows students to explore their own creativity and freedom within the style.

### CLASS STYLES

#### PRE-SCHOOL DANCE

Our Pre-School Dancers have their own program that is specifically designed for Pre-School aged children from 2 years of age. Our classes age appropriate focus on learning the foundations of Ballet, Jazz and Acro technique as well as guiding students to develop gross motor skills, musical awareness and coordination.

#### **TAP**

Tap is a traditional style of dance that is characterised by the percussive sounds of a tappers shoe striking the floor. Our structured tap classes focus on technique, musicality and coordination and all students are encouraged to participate in our end of year Showcase with their class routine.

#### **ACRO DANCE**

Acro Dance is a genre of dance which seamlessly fuses elements of lyrical tricks, balancing, tumbling and jazz helping to create versatile dancers. Our classes follow the Acrobatic Arts Syllabus where students are able to progress through class levels and skills as they advance. Students must develop a good foundation of strength and flexibility to achieve new skills, and with a steady approach students will reach their goals safely and effectively with correct technique.

#### **STRETCH + TECHNIQUE**

This technique class is designed to improve student flexibility, core strength, balance and range of skills. Students are taught the correct methods of stretching and what particular stretches benefit them in aid to perform a particular skill. This class is recommended for all performance students.

#### **PERFORMANCE**

ALSOD offers a number of performance classes and opportunities available to select dancers wishing to perform and compete both locally and interstate. These classes include Solo, Duo, Trio, Private Coaching, Mini Troupe and Troupe classes. Please contact us to express your interest in our performance classes.

# PRICING INFORMATION

#### **ENROLMENT FEES**

Annual registration/administration fees are \$35.00 per student OR \$55 for families with more than one child enrolling from the same household in 2024. All Private Lesson students are required to pay a \$25.00 annual fee to cover APRA, PPCA and copyright fees. Enrolment fees will be added to your Term 1 Invoice.

#### **FOOTWEAR**

Appropriate footwear must be worn to each class. If you need any assistance with shoes please talk to your childs teacher or see below for requirements -

JAZZ: Black slip on jazz shoes from Energetiks, Capezio or Bloch

**BALLET:** Ballet shoes with elastics from Energetiks, Capezio or Bloch

TAP: Black buckle up tap shoes. Lace up tap shoes allowed for Exams and Solos

HIP HOP: Sneakers/joggers are to be worn to class

LYRICAL: Barefoot

**CONTEMPORARY:** Barefoot

**ACRO:** Barefoot

#### **SHOWCASE**

Amanda Lee School of Dance holds an annual inclusive Showcase each year where we encourage all students to attend! #### SHOWCASE PACKAGE

All Showcase costs are kept to an absolute minimum where possible. Families are encouraged to keep previous years costumes as they are often reused or resold to other students. Costume deposits start being issued in Term 2 Invoices for participating students.

A one off Showcase Package fee will be applied to Term 4 Invoices that covers dancers participation, rehearsal and licensing fees, and all students will receive a trophy. More info in Term 4.
